There 64 'Caucus Members', with voting rights for the convection currently. There are about 17 people that have contributed to LPNM since the last convention that could qualify for voting status if they top up their contributions to the minimum. Their voter registration status is unknown, so it could be significantly less than 17 that could qualify. Members must have paid either \$72 or \$60 if they are also LP National members.

This must be paid in full 30 days prior to the convention, Feb 3rd.

The convention is March 5, at the ABQ Convention Center, 12:noon to 4pm

A notice was emailed out 15 days prior, and the day before the Constitutional Convention. The motion to hold such an event was passed by unanimous vote at the Central Committee meeting on Dec 19', it took a few days for the announcement to come out.

The matter of urgency is the perception of the Central Committee.
