We have reviewed your e-mail, and the attached letter. While we appreciate your desire to help fellow-Libertarians in matters of parliamentary procedure, your claim to have been "retained as... advisory Parliamentarian," as well as the substance of your letter, suggests that you are acting as an attorney in advising Mr. Askin what his legal rights are with respect to LPNM and what the legal effect of LPNM's recent convention is, and in representing him in communications with LPNM. As you are not an attorney - nor are you a member of LPNM - we cannot recognize your purported representation.

We are happy to correspond with Mr. Askin, or any other members of LPNM, regarding whatever concerns they may have regarding the Special Convention that took place on January 6, 2022. I do note that Mr. Askin not only received notice of the January 6, 2022 Special Convention, but also attended, and did not object to either the manner in which those proceedings were conducted, or the substance of the proposals that passed.
